Problems intruding on the attorney/client relationship are almost innumerable but this seminar focuses on confronting and avoiding conflicts detrimental to professionalism. MR 1.8(j) places a ban on attorney -client sexual relationships, but beyond legal ethics, professionalism mandates that attorneys be fiduciaries in all client matters. Here our focus is on just how far this goes?

Lawyer Substance Abuse/Addictions - Causes and Results by TRT (2.0 ethics, 2.0 total, 73153)

____ July 9, ____ July 30, ____ August 30,

Just how problematic is lawyer substance abuse? Studies purport that lawyers abuse substances at twice the rate of the general population and depressive episodes are twice as likely among female attorneys. Learning to spot symptoms early on of drug abuse and impairments will help the profession shift from a reactive to a proactive approach. The seminar concludes with a review of case law addressing rules of ethics affecting addictions and mental debilitation.

____ August 4, ____ August 31,

Compliance issues affect both management and general counsel. What is unique about the role of GC in modern corporations? Now that MR 1.6 and MR 1.13 are more aligned with SEC's implementation of Sarbanes-Oxley, 17 C.F.R. §205.3, what is the effect on general counsel? Has there been a shift in moral authority within corporate America? What does this portend for the future? These are but some of the salient issues addressed in this seminar.
